

VISA REQUIREMENTS FOR FOREIGN SPOUSE AND/OR PARENT OF MINOR FILIPINO CITIZENS TRAVELING TO THE PHILIPPINES

- NO NEED TO APPLY FOR A VISA IF TRAVELLING TOGETHER WITH FILIPINA SPOUSE UNDER THE **BALIKBAYAN PROGRAM**
- IF FILIPINA SPOUSE OR MINOR CHILD IS IN THE PHILIPPINES, A VISA MUST BE APPLIED
- COPIES OF THE REQUIREMENTS MUST BE SUBMITTED IN ADVANCE TO visa@philippine-embassy.de FOR ENDORSEMENT TO THE DFA; VISA WILL BE ISSUED AFTER RECEIPT OF THE DFA ENTRY EXEMPTION;
- REQUIREMENTS ARE AS FOLLOWS:
 1. Duly accomplished FA Form No. 2

 2. Original machine-readable passport with a minimum validity of six (6) months beyond the intended stay in the Philippines
 3. Photocopy of passport's data page
 4. Printed airline booking or itinerary of travel showing dates of arrival and departure from the Philippines
 5. proof of financial capacity (most recent bank statement and/or if employed, latest three (3) month payroll slip (*Lohnabrechnung*))
 6. Notarized letter request from the Filipino spouse/parent of minor Filipino children
 7. Proof of payment for the visa fee (**27,00 Euro**) transferred to the Embassy's bank account

 8. Return envelope preferably from reputable courier service providers (DHL, UPS or DPD) or self-addressed envelope with 4,05 Euro postage stamps (*Einschreiben*)

Additional Requirements

A. Foreign Spouse of a Filipino National

1. Original and one photocopy of Marriage Certificate from the Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA), if married in the Philippines
2. Original and one photocopy of Report of Marriage (ROM), if married abroad and has no PSA copy yet
3. Proof of Filipino citizenship of Spouse (e.g. copy of Philippine passport)
4. Proof that spouse is currently in the Philippines (e.g. Certification from the local government [Barangay/Municipality] stating their presence and residency in their locality)

B. Foreign Parent of Minor Filipino Children

1. Original and one photocopy of Birth Certificate from the Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA), if born in the Philippines
2. Original and one photocopy of PSA issued Report of Birth (ROB), if born abroad
3. Proof of Filipino citizenship of child (e.g. copy of Philippine passport)
4. Proof that child is currently in the Philippines (e.g. school/enrollment records)

IMPORTANT:

VISA-ISSUED FOREIGN NATIONALS MUST BE ABLE TO PRESENT, IF REQUIRED BY IMMIGRATION OFFICIALS AT THE AIRPORT, DOCUMENTARY PROOF OF FILIATION TO THE FILIPINO SPOUSE/PARENT TO AVOID POSSIBLE EXCLUSION OR DENIAL OF ENTRY BY BI OFFICIALS.
