in Philippine Civil Registry Records)

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

Philippines, to be my true and legal representative to act for and in my name and
stead, and on my behalf to do and execute any or all of the following acts, deeds,
and things, to wit:

- a. Have the divorce decree judicially confirmed in a Philippine Regional
Trial Court,
- b. Register the RTC confirmation/decision with PSA,
- c. Secure from the PSA a copy of your Report of Marriage / Certificate
of Marriage (if married in the Philippines) bearing the annotation of
divorce,
- d. Have the Annotated Report of Marriage authenticated by the
Department of Foreign Affairs (DFA), and;
- e. Send the authenticated annotated Report of Marriage / Marriage
Certificate to Germany.

HEREBY GIVING AND GRANTING unto my representative full power
and authority to execute and perform every act necessary to render effective the
special power granted in this instrument, as though I myself has so performed it,
and HEREBY APPROVING and RATIFYING ALL that he may do by virtue
thereof.
